A LIFELINE FOR VICTIMS OF TERROR

In the aftermath of the October 7 massacre,
The Jewish Agency's Fund for Victims of Terror,
supported by Keren Hayesod, became a vital lifeline
for thousands. Since the war began, Keren Hayesod
has raised US \$31 million, with US \$22 million
distributed in direct support in 2024, delivering critical
aid at an unprecedented scale. Additionally, US \$4.5
million* were raised in 2024 to ensure continued
support and future distribution.

Over 3,977 grants were distributed in mere days, marking an unprecedented response in the Fund's 21-year history.

This vital initiative ensures rapid and effective relief. Grants of up to \$6,300 have been provided to victims, covering essential needs such as psychological counseling, financial assistance, and job retraining. In response to the crisis, the Fund has also provided immediate aid to over 9,000 households, demonstrating the power of your generosity in action.

This is not just aid—it's resilience in action. Together, we are restoring lives, strengthening communities, and ensuring that Israel's unwavering spirit endures.
